Lantern Craft Making



The tradition of crafting and displaying Chinese lanterns to celebrate festivals dates to the Han Dynasty in China and is closely related to traditional Chinese culture and customs. In Singapore, lanterns are hung outside homes, temples, and clan associations, and are featured in lantern displays during celebrations such as the Spring Lantern Festival and the Mid-Autumn Festival.

The dragon dance is a traditional Chinese performance where a team of dancers uses poles to animate a dragon prop with rhythmic movements. This dance is commonly performed during Chinese festivals such as the Lunar New Year and the Mid-Autumn Festival, as well as other special occasions.

Create your paper dragon garland, mimicking the traditional dragon dance, and watch it come to life in your hands once assembled!
